Presentations can be scheduled throughout the school year and tailored to fit your curriculum.

Here is a list of some of our most popular lessons:

Money and Your Plan is designed to help students begin to understand personal finance. The importance of tracking your spending, creating a budget, understanding individual needs/wants, and saving/investing for the future are all introduced in this interactive session. (45-50 min)

Careers and Income will encourage students to explore the various needs and wants they will likely encounter in adulthood. They will have the opportunity to make individual lifestyle choices and see if their intended career can support their “dream” lifestyle. (45-50 min)

Your Money...You Decide is a hands-on interactive simulation exercise designed to better position students when making life-like spending choices with their income. This activity takes place during the student’s action-packed senior year of high school and requires them to track their income and all their expenditures in a ledger. Consequences of overspending are discussed while students are challenged to live within their means. (45-50 min)
