

HOW DO I FIND MY ACCOUNT NUMBER?



SAVINGS & CHECKING

Savings and checking account numbers begin with 1, then the two digit account ID (00, 06, 15... found on your TLC statement or in online banking). These three numbers are followed by “zeros” then your account number. Your account number and zeros will equal 10 digits. (Please note....the last digit of your account number may be a “zero”.)

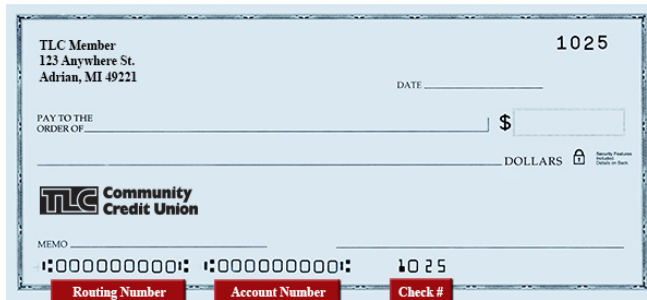
Example:

1 + 00 + 000 + 1234567

“Sav/ck”+ “ID”+ “Zeros”+ “Account No”.

Put together this would read 1000001234567. There should be 13 digits total with no dashes or spaces.

You can also find your routing and account number at the bottom of your checks:



LOAN PAYMENT

Loan payment account numbers begin with 2, then the two digit loan ID (00, 01, 02...) found on your TLC statement or in online banking. These three numbers are followed by “zeros” then your account number. Your account number and zeros will equal 10 digits. (Please note....the last digit of your account number may be a “zero”.)

Example:

2 + 01 + 000 + 1234567

“Loan”+ “ID”+ “Zeros”+ “Account No”

Put together this would read 2010001234567. There should be 13 digits total with no dashes or spaces.
